2.00 PM – INTRODUCTION AND TUTORED TASTING OF DIFFERENT PORT STYLES

No need to worry about confusing your LBVs with your tawnies, Colin Gent MW will guide you through the essential styles. Following a meet and greet, take your seats for a gentle warm-up information session, focusing on Port, its long history, and an explanation of the different styles, all illustrated with a tasting of some classic examples.

TAYLOR'S PORT LODGE

A quick walk from the hotel brings us to one of the most illustrious "lodges" in Vila Nova. Lodges are the historic wine cellar complexes where young Ports – freshly arrived from their wineries upriver in the Douro – are laid down for ageing in barrel. The cooler, more humid climate here is much more conducive to slow qualitative ageing than in the hot, dry high Douro Valley. The Taylors cellars are 300 years old, and all their best Ports are aged here. WELCOME DINNER AT BARAO FLADGATE RESTAURANT

Without having to leave the Taylor's Port Lodge, we move from the tasting to our welcome dinner in the excellent house restaurant. As well as great food and wines plucked from the adjacent cellars, the restaurant features magnificent views over the river to Porto. TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 16TH – THE LODGES OF VILA NOVA DE GAIA

10.00 am - Depart Hotel

GRAHAM'S PORT LODGE

We will be welcomed to the 1890 Lodge where the ports are slumbering during their long ageing process. Naturally there will be a tasting before we have a special lunch in their Vinum restaurant, which has a wonderful view of the river. The chef uses ingredients from local producers and fish from the cold Atlantic to produce a menu for us, which is paired with a great selection of wines. <u>www.grahams-port.com</u>

KOPKE PORT LODGE

The third of our trio of Port Lodges, Kopke is actually the oldest of all Port companies, dating its creation back to 1638. The house is known for its specialization in small quantities of rare, extra-long aged Ports, including an extraordinary range of historic single vintage dated tawnies, called *colheitas*. If you have never experienced this style of Port, you are in for a real treat! And they serve them with chocolate...!! www.kopke1638.com

PRIVATE RIVER CRUISE

After so much sensory overload, what better way to relax than a late afternoon boat trip. Cruising gently upriver, we pass under the famous Dom Luis Bridge, which was designed by Gustave Eiffel, who famously also built the Eiffel Tower and the Statue of Liberty. As we return, we can observe the bustling Porto quayside from the comfort of our boat, before heading back to the Vila Nova side.

We return to the Yeatman at around 7.00 pm. Tonight is a free evening to relax and explore the restaurants and tasting bars of Vila Nova de Gaia.

Please be checked out and ready because the next stage of the adventure involves some traveling. Fortunately, we have a perfect opportunity to break the journey halfway and sample the light, vibrant wines of Vinho Verde.

QUINTA DA AVELEDA

Aveleda is the leading producer of Vinho Verde. Light in alcohol with a hint of spritz, these are unique and wonderfully refreshing wines. Aveleda is also a magical place to visit, an elegant country house dating back to the 16th century. A stroll through the beautiful historic gardens offers a moment of enchantment before we continue on to the Douro Valley.

QUINTA DE LA ROSA

We arrive just in time for lunch, which is fortunate because the restaurant here – Cozinha de Clara – is one of the best in the region. Quinta de la Rosa is a boutique, family-owned estate, the first of its kind to commercialize its own production rather than sell to the big shippers. As well as a full range of Ports, the estate makes excellent "table wines" (classic dry wines with no extra fortification), under the direction of star winemaker, Jorge Moreira. <u>www.quintadelarosa.com</u>

QUNTA DA ROEDA

We now have the opportunity for a wonderful hands-on, or rather feet-on, experience: grape treading in the traditional *lagares*! Still today, foot treading is considered to be the best way of extracting colour and tannins for the finest ports. Shorts and t-shirts are provided and dancing is encouraged! Grape stomping is huge fun!

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 18TH – PINHÃO

10.00 am - Depart Hotel

All the best pilgrimages start with a climb up the hill. This one we will do from the comfort of our luxury bus.

QUINTA DO NOVAL

This is the estate all Port lovers dream of visiting, the unofficial 'Premier Grand Cru Classé' of Douro estates. Home of the legendary Quinta do Noval Nacional, the entire range of Ports is simply mind-blowing, and there is now a range of outstanding table wines being made here too. Even the olive oil here is sensational! www.quintadonoval.com

QUINTA DA GRICHA

Gricha belongs to Churchill's, an independent Port company established a generation ago by Johnny Graham. The Gricha estate provides the best grapes for Churchill's famously drier style of Ports, as well as for their highly-regarded table wines. It is also an amazing place to visit, with breathtaking views in all directions. An informal al-fresco lunch out amongst the vines here provides a truly memorable experience, a moment of bliss in the middle of a great day. <u>www.drinkchurchills.com</u>

QUINTA DO BOMFIM

Back to Pinhão for our last stop, Quinta do Bomfim, home to the famous Dow's Port brand. The vineyards here cling to terraces on steep slopes overlooking the river, providing a photogenic backdrop to the house and gardens. The welcome is always warm here, the wines delicious, naturally. 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- ITINERARY | DAY 5

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 19TH – UPPER DOURO

10.30 AM - DEPART HOTEL

Be sure to have checked out by departure time and have your luggage ready for storage at the hotel. It is a 5 minute walk to the train station, but we will return briefly to the hotel before heading back to Porto & Vila Nova de Gaia.

TRAIN TO THE UPPER DOURO

For many years, the entire Douro region was accessible only by boat or train, and even now the train is the most practical – as well as the most scenic – way to access the wild, mountainous lands beyond Pinhão. Upper Douro is the name given to the easternmost of the 3 districts within the Douro demarcated zone. Hotter and drier than the Cima Corgo, this is where the fullest-bodied and most powerful Ports come from. There are only a handful of trains per day, but a couple of famous Port lodges actually have their own train stations (where else in the world...?), and it would be a shame to miss out on visiting this grandiose landscape.

QUINTA DO VESUVIO

This is actually the family home of the Symington clan, who own and assure day-to-day management of Graham's, Warre's, Dow's, Cockburn's, and a host of other historic Port brands. Located in splendid isolation on a bend of the river, below towering rock escarpments, the fine 19th century buildings still house a functioning traditional press room, where teams of treaders stomp the grapes in shallow open granite *lagares*. The combination of concentrated grapes from the steep vineyards plus the traditional pressing by foot make Vesuvio wines and Ports some of the darkest, richest, and most intense you can find. The Symingtons are always very welcoming hosts, so we will be beyond royally wined, dined, and entertained before it is time to start our journey home. www.symington.com/winery/vesuvio-winery

RETURN TO PORTO & VILA NOVA

All good things have to come to an end, but we do get to ride the train again back to Pinhão before the bus takes us on the last leg, dropping guests first off at the Yeatman in Vila Nova and on to Porto airport by 7.30pm. The exact timings are subject to the Portuguese train schedules, to be confirmed in early 2025.
